- Keyboards and mice
- Point of sale equipment
- Wifi routers and networking equipment
- Speakers and sound systems
- Printers, copiers and fax machines
- Monitors, and screens
- Telecommunications equipment (phone, webcams, mic's, any phone equipment)
- Any sort of cables
- TV's and CRT TV's
- Video games, DVD's and CD's
- DVD/VHS/CS/MP3 players
- Hard drives and data storage equipment.
- Server(s) and Server equipment
- House hold electronics (such as toasters, microwaves, blenders, etc.)

- Please bring used polystyrene foam including post-consumer foam cups and "to-go" containers, egg cartons, ice chests, rinsed meat trays, protective packaging foam (Frequently used to protect electronics during shipping), and other foam with the #6 inside the chasing arrows triangle.
- Please rinse or wipe off your containers prior to depositing them.
- Please place your foam in a see-through bag before depositing.
- We can not accept packaging peanuts.
- Please remove lids, straws, packaging tape, and labels.
